Pursuant to Seabrook City Charter, Section 7.04(b) a candidate who shall receive a majority of votes cast for such position shall be declared elected. In the event that no candidate receives a majority of votes cast **for that position**, a run-off election shall be held between the two (2) candidates who receive the greatest number of votes for such position. Run-off election information for At-Large Position No. 1 will be released as soon as it is available.

Texas Secretary of State defines majority as “more than 50%. If no candidate receives more than 50% of the vote in an election requiring a majority, then a runoff election is required between the top two vote getters.”
