

Voter Precincts were last revised in 2002, by the Otero County Commissioners and County Administrator, Barry Shioshita.

Mr. Shioshita worked with the GIS Technician / County Mapper, Stephen Lange to incorporate the 2000 Census data, in the form of Census Blocks, which were supplied by the US Government in digital form. You will note that the Precinct boundaries sometime refer to the census blocks as references.

Since then, the Precinct definitions have remained the same. The city and town boundaries, also used as references at times, have changed, but so far, those changes have not affected the Precinct lines.

The overall digital mapping work is on-going and improving all the time, but the various levels/feature layers are still not fully aligned, as the quantity of data is immense, especially for just one person to process. Many of these layers have been created from scratch, using copies of the original surveys, plats, aerial ortho-photos, and many other references.

I present this project as the most up-to-date record available in this election year and it replaces all previous projects.
